ALL UNDERSTANDING OF REVELATION BEGINS WITH THE TORAH

Series Part 1 of 10 The Year 6,000 and Deciphering Revelation Using the Torah

Hello, and welcome to my 10 part video series titled "The Year 6,000 and Deciphering Revelation Using the Torah".

This is video 1 of the series. We are going to first discuss a book that most believers ignore or reject, but it is the most fundamental book in understanding everything regarding the New Testament and Book of Revelation, and it is the Torah of Moses. It's what makes this video series unique and different from anything you've probably ever heard anywhere else, because I discuss Revelation in the context of the Torah, the foundation of everything. In the Torah is also the knowledge of the year 6,000, which is the most important year in the history of all humanity. The people of Judaism that keep Torah already know and teach regarding the year 6,000, and even have a count from the year of creation, the AM year, that leads to the year 6,000, which according to the rabbis of Judaism is when the Mashiach must appear. However, the official Jewish AM year from creation is in error and is behind 213 years. I will discuss this in greater detail in video number 4. So, the Jews actually already know the Mashiach comes in the year 6,000, but most do not realize it is actually his second coming, not his first coming. The year 6,000 has been taught for thousands of years and is found in many ancient texts, even outside of Judaism, but many people have also been decived by a lie that the earth is billions of years old, which blocks them from understanding and also preparing for the year 6,000. And many believers have misinterpreted the scripture, "no one knows the day nor the hour", which I will clarify in video number 4. All of human history can truly be summed up to less than 6,000 years, using the genealogies and timelines of the Bible, which is a true historical book.

I will discuss the year 6,000 in video number 4, and will show you how many years are left until that very important year based on my extensive research and the precise timeline I have developed, which is all based on the genealogies and timelines of the Bible. Very few people and historians in the history of all humanity have derived the true and exact number we are in since creation, if any at all, although some have come very close. I will present to you the true number we are in since creation in video number 4. This information is extremely valuable. And once you understand how close we are to the year 6,000, then everything that is now happening in the world will make a lot more sense. But first we will discuss the Torah.

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To understand the book of Revelation, we have to first know and understand the foundation of the entire New Testament, and it is the Old Testament, which in Hebrew is also called the Tanakh.

The word Tanakh is an acronym for the three sections it contains, the Torah, the Neviim, and the Ketuvim. T-N-K, Tanakh.

The Neviim are the writings of the prophets, such as Isaiah, Ezekiel, and Daniel.

The Ketuvim are other writings, such as the Chronicles and the Psalms.

And then the Torah are the writings of Moses, such as Genesis and Exodus. We are going to focus on the Torah in this video.

And throughout this video series we will periodically be referring back to the Tanakh and its three sections to understand passages in the New Testament and also the book of Revelation.

You might have seen a Torah already, which is a very long scroll written in Hebrew inside a beautiful ornate encasing. It is common to see them in Israel and in Jewish synagogues. The cases look like large trophies. They come in different styles and sizes.

This is my torah scroll here at my house, and it is handwritten in Hebrew, brought here from Jerusalem. Every handwritten copy of the Torah is meticulously inspected to verify that not even one dot is missing. Creating this handwritten copy of the Torah was very laborious. My Torah case is covered with turquoise crystals. It is my most loved possession, the Torah of God.

The Torah is essentially the first 5 books of the Bible, which is why it is also called the Pentateuch. "Penta" meaning five. The books are Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.

The Torah is not some book from some other religion, like for example the Quran in the Islamic religion. Many people confuse the Islamic religion with the Jewish religion, and they confuse the Quran with the Torah. They are two religions and two completely different books. Some people even think Arabs and Jews are the same thing. There is much ignorance.

The Torah contains the real words that came from the mouth of the living God on Mount Sinai and is inside everyone's Bibles, both Protestant and Catholic Bibles. The Torah itself is actually already part of christianity, although many believers ignore or reject its commands. But almost all protestants and catholics do know the general story of Genesis and Exodus in the Torah.

Everyone has a copy of the Torah in their own bibles and in their own language. It is actually the most printed book in the world and the book that has been translated into the most languages, along with the other books in the Bible. So you don't even need to know Hebrew to read the Torah. Just read it from your own Bible, in your own language, starting in Genesis.

The Jewish Torah is in fact the original Bible, before there even was a New Testament and book of Revelation.

"In the beginning God began to create the heavens and the earth". Genesis 1:1. That is the first sentence in the Torah. It's in everyone's bibles.

But many protestant and catholic believers ignore the Torah or reject it, because they think that its an old law that is now abolished that we no longer need to know and obey, not understanding that the Torah is the foundation of the all the truth of God and the entire New Testament. And it is the key to understanding the book of Revelation.

I even did a test to see what people think about the Torah in christian groups on the internet and created the following post, "The Torah has not been abolished and it is still required to be obeyed", and take a look at these responses I received.

Just these few responses pretty much summarize the general consensus of most Protestants and Catholics throughout the entire world regarding the Torah. And many of them actually despise people that teach the Torah.

In summary, they think, "we don't need the Torah", so they never bother to study it. And this is precisely the problem, because when you reject the Torah, you not only reject its commands that all reveal what is good and evil, but you also reject its appointed times that all reveal when the events of the book of Revelation must happen, which includes the knowledge of the year 6,000. So by rejecting a book they need to know, they unknowingly blind themselves. And also bring destruction upon themselves, because anyone who rejects the Torah and does not obey it will be destroyed at the return of Yeshua.

Yeshua will tell many believers, "depart from me you workers of anomia". "Anomia" means without Torah in Greek.

As such, these appointed times found in the Torah are crucial to understanding Revelation and knowing when those events must happen. These are the set-apart times of God, such as Pesach, Shavuot, Yom Teruah, Yom Kippur, Sukkot, and the shabbath. I will teach you these sacred times in the next video, and correlate them with the events of the first and second comings of Yeshua, and the book of Revelation.

These sacred times are essentially the appointed times of this entire earth, from beginning to end, from the time it was created to the time it will cease to exist, 7,000 years total.

And they lay down the entire plan of salvation for all humanity on this temporary earth throughout its 7 millennia that it was appointed to exist, each covering an important aspect of the general plan of salvation of God with the goal for the inhabitants of this current earth to arrive at the New Jerusalem in the new heavens and new earth that God will create, which is the true promised land, and the final and permanent destination of all those who believed and obeyed God on this earth. Whereas those who did not believe and did not obey will cease to exist along with this earth.

On Pesach at the first coming of Yeshua we have the forgiveness of sins with the death and sacrifice of Yeshua.

At Hag Hamatzot we remove sin.

On Shavuot we receive the anointing.

On Yom Teruah the 7 trumpets of God are blasted at the return of Yeshua.

On Yom Kippur is the gathering of the people of God, which is commonly called the rapture.

These are some examples of the sacred times of God. I am going to teach you the sacred times of God found in the Torah of Moses in video number 3 in this series.

And these sacred times are based on a lunar calendar established by God from the beginning.

I am going to teach you this lunar calendar in the next video and then the appointed times of the Torah in video 3, so you can truly understand Revelation and the events of the second coming of Yeshua. These are not teachings you are going to find in the ordinary protestant and catholic churches, because they all discard the Torah. To truly understand the New Testament and book of Revelation you have to first know and understand the Torah, the foundation of it all.

And step by step we will continue building knowledge on this foundation in each video in this series, until we have a full understanding of Revelation and know when we can expect those events to happen. The Torah and its appointed times and calendar lay it all down for us to know and understand. So it is essential that you watch each video in order from the beginning, because each video constructs on the knowledge of the previous video.

So why do most people ignore or reject the Torah? It really began with the Romans. The Roman emperors, who later became known as Roman popes, previously took the Jewish teachings of Yeshua, and disassociated the Jewish Torah that they hated from his teachings, and created a new religion to strengthen their authority in the Roman Empire, which mixed some of their own pagan teachings with the teachings of Yeshua, which became known as "catholicism", when then became "protestantism" as we know it today, with an idea of a "Jesus" and trinitarian God that is completely foreign to judaism and the Torah and Yeshua.

They even created a false priesthood that mimicked the Levitical priesthood of the Torah, and changed the shabbath of the Torah to Sunday, and even deified different Biblical persons, such as the apostles and Mary, and presented Yeshua to the world as a mere baby in subjection to the mother of God Mary, while discarding the Torah of God. All of this has happened in fulfillment of prophecy, because the Roman succession

of authority that began with emperors then became popes are the antichrist, and they are the ones who were destined to deceive the entire world, which has already happened. I explain this in greater detail in video number 7.

Modern day Catholicism and Protestantism are essentially false religions that negate the Jewish Torah that Yeshua himself practiced and taught and also expects us to obey. The true religion of Yeshua is Judaism, and that never changed.

"I did not come to abolish the Torah".

"Not one jot or one tittle will fall from the Torah until all is fulfilled"

These are the words of Yeshua.

The entire Torah and all its appointed times will be fulfilled at the return of Yeshua once his 1,000 year rulership is completed, which are the final 1,000 years of the total 7,000 years appointed for the existence of this earth. Then and only then all the written Torah will be completely fulfilled and will pass away, because its appointed times correspond to this earth and it will no longer be necessary in a new heavens and new earth where everyone will be righteous and will already have the Torah of God written in their inner minds.

And many believers have also misunderstood the writings of the apostle Paul. Paul was a Jew, a son of Israel, also from the Tribe of Benjamin, and a Pharisee, and was taught the entire Torah by the rabbi Gamaliel.

He merely summarized and simplified his own writings so that his Gentile audience could easily understand what he was telling them, because they weren't raised in Judaism to know the Torah and what God expected from everyone. In reality everything the apostle Paul taught came from the Torah. This is why he also said,

Do we then nullify the Torah by our belief? No, we uphold the Torah

The apostle Paul actually taught the Torah and obedience to it. When Paul told his audience that murders and thieves will not inherit the kingdom of God, it wasn't because he thought that, it was because the Torah commanded it.

You shall not murder you shall not steal Even in the book of Acts, when the gentiles were told not to eat blood, it wasn't because the apostles thought that, it was because the Torah commanded it. you shall not eat blood.

It is actually one of the oldest commands in the Torah that God gave humanity even before Moses. When Noah came out of the ark, God gave him and all humanity permission to now eat animals, with one condition, do not eat its blood. This command was not just for Noah, or not just for Israel, it was for all humanity. That is why the apostles repeated it in the book of Acts, because it came from the Torah, for all humanity.

And so, essentially Yeshua and all the apostles taught Judaism, based on the Torah of Moses. It was never abolished. It was the Romans who discarded it and taught the world to do the same, in their new religion, which has influenced the entire world. And that explains why many Protestants and Catholics today have no idea about the Torah and do not even know its most basic commands such as abstaining from blood.

Most believers have misunderstood and have been deceived, and have discarded the most foundational aspect in understanding Revelation and the New Testament, and it is the Torah.

So as you continue watching this series it will slowly become more apparent that almost everything you've been taught is a lie. My recommendation is to unlearn everything you've been taught by the mainstream Protestant and Catholic Churches, and watch these videos with the mentality of a child, ready to learn. And also remember, Judaism is an ancient religion, thousands of years old even before Yeshua appeared, and practiced by millions of people all around the world. It is not a cult. It is a solid foundation and it is the religion Yeshua practiced and the one we must also practice, in the context of the belief in him. Which is also what made his Judaism different than the one practiced by the Pharisees, because he had belief, and more importantly, love, which is where they lacked. Belief and love are the weightier matters of the Torah more than wearing Tzitzit and affixing mezuzot on the doorposts.

Love God with all your inner mind

Love your neighbor as yourself

These commands are in the Torah and came from God, before Yeshua. They are not new commands given by Yeshua.

I will explain more about how the torahless Roman Catholic religion has deceived the entire world in video number 7. And this disassociation of the Torah from the teachings of Yeshua is what blinds most believers, never really understanding when the events of the book of Revelation must happen according to the appointed times of the Torah and its calendar. They erroneously think that the second coming of Yeshua and the events of the book of Revelation can happen at any time, not understanding that they must happen according to the appointed times of the Torah.

And without knowledge of the Torah it is impossible to truly understand the New Testament and the book of Revelation. Which is why Paul said,

"you have in the Torah the embodiment of knowledge and truth"

So where did the Torah come from? In summary,

As part of the entire plan of salvation for all humanity, God wanted to first establish a new nation set apart from all other nations, that he himself planted with signs of power, in a land he chose and determined its boundaries, and appear to them and verbally give them a good and wise law to be governed by, to serve as an example to all other nations of the earth. And in that law also give appointed times that this nation should observe, like holidays, which would wisely and secretly largely establish the appointed times of this entire earth for all humanity.

So, to achieve this, God first chose a particular man named Abram in Mesopotamia, whom God later changed his name to Abraham, and called him out of his people. God revealed to him his Torah and his commandments and tested him. Abraham believed and obeyed the commands of God and passed the test of God.

So God established a pact with him to build the nation that God wanted, from his offspring, which today we know as the people of Israel.

And to give him and his offspring the land where the nation of Israel is currently located, which was formerly called the land of Canaan.

With the purpose of being nation that was governed by the commands of God, which is the Torah of Moses, to serve as an example to all nations of the world.

And the sign of that pact that God established with Abraham was the circumcision. Every pact of God has a sign. For example, the sign of the pact God made with all humanity to never flood the earth again was the rainbow.

Then around 430 years later after God called Abraham, God first appeared to Moses in a burning bush and chose him to go Egypt to free the nation of Israel from oppressive slavery there, to then give them the land that God had promised their ancestor, Abraham,

Moses then appeared to Pharaoh on behalf of God and told him to free the nation of Israel, but Pharaoh refused, which God appointed would happen so that through the stubbornness of Pharah he may reveal his tremendous power,

So God then with his power struck Egypt with severe plagues to force Pharaoh to free the nation of Israel, but plague after plague Pharaoh still refused to let the nation of Israel go, as God has appointed would happen,

God turned their water into blood God sent them frogs God struck them with boils God rained hail and fire upon them God plunged them into darkness Then God killed all their firstborn, because Pharaoh did not want to release the first nation established by God, Israel, the firstborn nation of God,

Finally after so many plagues and Egypt was left in ruins Pharaoh stopped resisting and let the nation of Israel go, and God lead them into the desert, to the Red Sea. But Pharaoh once again resisted the will of God, and sent his armies to pursue the nation of Israel.

So God divided the Red Sea, and lead the nation of Israel through it, and the armies of Pharaoh continued in pursuit through it, but God closed the waters in on them, and so the Red Sea devoured them.

God then brought the nation of Israel to Mount Sinai in the Sinai desert,

And there an angel in the representation of God descended upon Mount Sinai, in power with fire and the mountain was shaken and there was lightning and dark clouds, in the presence of the entire nation of Israel, who were terrified to see all of this. And there God verbally gave them commands, which Moses then wrote down in a book, which became known as the Torah of Moses. The Torah of Moses is essentially also the Law of God, because these commands literally came from the mouth of God. Moses just wrote what he heard.

Some commands were even written by the finger of God, which became known as the "ten commandments". This is why the Torah is so sacred, even more than the texts written by the prophets, because the words written therein literally and audibly and visibly came from God in the presence of an entire nation of people. It is the most sacred text of all humanity, containing the literal words of the living God that created all of us.

As such, the Hebrew word "Torah" means "instruction". These instructions came from God, for Israel and also for all humanity. You shall not murder is not just for Israel, it is for all humanity. Even the weekly shabbath is for all humanity, not just Israel. Everyone needs a day to rest in the week. And the millennial shabbath it foreshadows is for all humanity, not just Israel was only meant to serve as an example to all humanity, and God intended all humanity to learn from Israel and its law and admire it and put it into practice also.

God verbally gave them commands that revealed everything that is good and evil, which Moses wrote down in the Torah, such as,

do not steal do not murder do not gossip open your hand to the poor forgive debts every 7 years love the foreigner as yourself

And God gave them commands to set them apart from everyone else, such as, you shall wear tzitzit

The tzitzit are the blue fringes you commonly see Jews wear in a four cornered garment called a tallit. It is meant to remind us to obey the commands of God, and also to set us apart to let other people know that the person wearing them believes and obeys the Torah.

Yeshua wore them and God expects us all to wear them also. Here are my tzitzit. you shall affix mezuzah

The mezuzah are objects that contain a parchment with the words of God in them. Any time you go to a Jewish home you will commonly see a mezuzah affixed to the side of the door. God expects all of us to put mezuzah on our doorposts. It's not just for Israel, it's for all humanity. Its sets apart our homes and lets people outside know that people that believe and obey the Torah live inside that home. And it also reminds us again to obey the commands of God.

And God also gave them appointed times and feasts, based on a lunar calendar, which Moses also wrote down in the Torah.

These appointed times and feasts aren't just ordinary ceremonies, but they came from God and based on the events of the first coming of Yeshua we have come to understand that they dictate when the events of the first coming and second coming of Yeshua must happen. For example, Yeshua died in the exact moment the Torah commanded that the Passover lamb had to be killed in the 14th day of the first new moon.

Then Yeshua was resurrected 3 days and 3 nights later in the exact moment the Torah commanded that the first fruits of barley was to be offered.

Were these coincidences? No, the appointed times of the Torah established when the events of the first coming of Yeshua had to happen, 1,490 years before Yeshua was anointed. This is incredible. The Torah was really meant to point to Yeshua.

And then at the second coming of Yeshua his angels will blast the trumpets that the Torah commands to blast on the 1st day of the 7th new moon.

This is why the second coming of Yeshua is associated with the blast of trumpets.

Is this another coincidence? No. Yeshua returns to continue fulfilling the appointed times of the Torah. Not all of them were fulfilled by him, because there are ones that correspond to his first coming, and then there are ones that correspond to his second coming. This is why the appointed times of the Torah are divided in two main groups, the ones of the spring, and then the ones of the autumn. The spring ones correspond to his first coming, and the autumn ones correspond to his second coming. I will explain this more in depth in video number 3.

These are just a few examples where we see how the Torah dictates important events in the first and second comings of Yeshua. These are not coincidences between the appointed times of the Torah and events in Yeshua, but rather God gave Moses and the nation of Israel these setapart times thousands of years prior to the events they represent in Yeshua, so that we who live farther into the future during the heavenly and then earthly rulership of Yeshua may study them and know what to expect and when, in our time, and also admire the wisdom and plan of God. Yet only those who study them have benefit and can see and are enriched in wisdom, whereas those who are ignorant or reject them are blinded. This is why Paul said,

These are shadows of things to come.

So remember, each of these appointed times and feasts have a symbolic representation of significant and real events found in the first and second comings of Yeshua, and they must happen at specific times in accordance to the lunar calendar of the Torah. In the next video I am going to teach you the lunar calendar of the Torah, and I will teach you how to observe the moon to know what is the current day of the month in the Jewish calendar. Again, this is not something you're going to learn in the Protestant and Catholic Churches.

And then I am going to teach you the appointed times of the Torah and how they dictate the timing of the events of first and second comings of Yeshua in part 3 of this video series. And then we will move on to the topic of the mark of the beast much later on in this series. You probably have never heard the explanation I am going to give you regarding the mark of the beast, because my explanation comes from the context of the Torah in what it reveals regarding money and righteous weights. So again I say, all of this is not information you're going to ordinarily find anywhere else. So please continue watching. Take notes. Rewatch the videos also if necessary, because this is a lot of information and you may not understand the first time. And share this information and videos with others, so that others may also be informed.

All of this information I make available to you for free. I make no money from these videos or any of my publications, unlike the megachurch pastors who sell their books and content. I simply love the truth that is in the scriptures and the Torah and love volunteering my time to help others acquire knowledge and understanding of the same, hence the name of my website, "Wisdom of God".

And because most believers reject the Torah is why all of them that read the book of Revelation have no deep understanding when those events must happen, because they do not know its commands and appointed times and calendar. The Torah is the other half of what a person needs to know to have complete understanding of everything. This is where believers of Yeshua fall short, in their lack of knowledge of the Torah. That is why there are so many clowns and charlatans teaching in large churches, knowing nothing about God according to what the Torah reveals to us about him, and collecting money from foolish believers who also do not know the Torah. They are all extremely deceived and clueless.

And they are the ones who will be cast out at the return of Yeshua, because they did not know nor obey the Torah.

The Greek word "anomia" means someone who discards the Torah, which is the Law of God.

Whereas the Jews fall short in their lack of belief in Yeshua, which then blinds them from the other half of what is needed to be known, which is the book of Revelation, which comes through belief in Yeshua. It is the Revelation of Yeshua.

The Torah dictates when the events of the first and second comings of Yeshua need to happen, and the book of Revelation tells us what exactly will happen at those precise times given in the Torah. The Torah says blast the trumpets on the 1st day of the seventh new moon. And the book of Revelation tells us that it will be 7 trumpets and what will happen with each trumpet blast. Both sides are necessary to know to know everything, knowledge of the Torah and knowledge of the book of Revelation, which comes through belief in Yeshua. The Jews know the Torah well but they do not know Revelation because they do not believe in Yeshua. So to them the appointed times of the Torah are merely just ceremonies that Moses passed down to them. And the Protestants and Catholics know the book of Revelation well but they do not know the Torah because they discard it as an old irrelevant law. So to them the events in the book of Revelation are merely just events that must happen at some unknown time in the future, not knowing that they are events that must happen at precise times precise times precise times precise times the Torah.

I am going to teach you both to give you the full understanding of everything, the book of Revelation in the context of the Torah of Moses. You will know what will happen, and when, having knowledge of both.
